Minor Rules

The Minor Division is an extension of the Mini-Minor Division and is considered instructional. Official score keeping and standings are NOT kept. Anyone 7 years of age as of August 1 through league age of 12 is eligible.

- 1. Team Selection:** Selections are blind drawn and overseen by the Player Agent.
- 2. Pitcher:** Pitchers are allowed 6 innings per week and not more than 3 innings per game. A week starts Sunday and ends Saturday. Player's leagues age 12 are not permitted to pitch. A player removed from pitching is not permitted to pitch again that same game.
- 3. Batting:** All players present must be on the batting line-up and must bat. All players must play at least 6 defensive outs. The batting order is independent of the defensive line-up.
- 4. 9 Batting Rule:** A side is retired after the 9th batter or 3 outs. If the 9th batter walks the inning is over as soon as he/she touches 1st base. Only the runs scored on that play will count.
- 5. Throwing the Bat:** See general rules.
- 6. Starting Play:** Games must start on time. A 10 minute wait is allowed only to field a team thereafter starts the game despite being short players. It is okay to borrow players from opposing teams if agreed. There are no forfeits since scoring and/or standings are not kept. If a game is scheduled to start following your game on the same field then a 2 hour time limit is applied. Games Must Not Start Later Than 10 Minutes After Scheduled Start Time.
